**LAS VEGAS SYMPHONY** - for the City's Centennial Celebration (in four movements) [26:05]

Las Vegas's history in a musical tour of four representative gaming properties.

1. **Hidden Springs/Pioneer Club.** "The Meadows" teemed with wildlife for centuries; song birds; a fledgling quail scurries to join his family. That tranquility is broken by the raucous Pioneer Club, representing the pre- and post-1931 gambling halls of Old Las Vegas; place your bets, pull on a one-armed bandit, hit a jackpot! [5:46]

2. **Legions, Ancient and Modern.** Ancient Rome on the Strip! Wander through Las Vegas's first fully "themed" resort.
